

# BOAT RAMP ACCESS AGREEMENT

To maintain security and the private use of Lake Columbia, the following policy is effective January 1, 2022:

One access may be issued per primary access, per household. Member must be in good standing and provide watercraft registration beyond the current year for each watercraft to have access to Lake Columbia. A \$25 deposit is required, with an endorsement of the access policy form, provided at LCPOA. Deposit is fully refundable when access to Lake Columbia is no longer needed.

Co-owners of primary properties (meeting the above member conditions) may obtain an additional access with a \$25 refundable deposit and by signing a separate Boat Ramp Access Agreement.

By signing this agreement the Member acknowledges that allowing others to utilize their Boat Ramp Access is a violation of LCPOA Policy and will result in sanctions being taken by LCPOA. Sanctions will be administered by the LCPOA as follows:

Minor violation (including, but not limited to, leaving cables down, leaving padlock unlocked, or allowing other members to use your access),

- 1st offence – Written reminder from LCPOA,
- 2nd offence – Written warning from LCPOA that next offence will result in 2 week suspension of ramp access to lake,
- 3rd offence – Written reprimand from LCPOA and 2 week suspension of ramp access, and
- 4th offense – Written reprimand from LCPOA and suspension of ramp access for the remainder of the year.

Major violation (including, but not limited to, allowing non-members to use your access or destruction of LCPOA ramp equipment),

- 1st offense - Written reprimand from LCPOA and suspension of ramp access for the remainder of the year.
