

## BOAT RAMP ACCESS POLICY

Effective April 1, 2022, the following policy has been adopted regarding the issuance of boat ramp access to members:

1. All Members must have paid the current year dues and all delinquent dues and be a member in good standing.
2. All Members must present a watercraft registration, valid beyond the current year, in their name, and complete a new Boat Ramp Access Policy Agreement.
3. Normally, only one ramp access per primary lot will be issued. As an exception, other deeded owner/members from different households may receive additional ramp access by paying a \$25 administration fee and completing a separate Boat Ramp Policy Agreement.
4. **Members having an email and cell phone number used for ramp access on file:** may exchange that email and/or cell phone number at the Association Office for a new ramp access.
5. **Members never having been issued a ramp access:** must pay a \$25 administration fee. The \$25 deposit from a return key can be exchanged for the \$25 administration fee. A returned key from multiple owners or households key deposit of \$200 will be refunded \$175 and \$25 applied to the administration fee.

Members obtaining ramp access are responsible for their ramp access use. Please do not provide your ramp access to others to launch their watercraft.

The Association is limited in its ability to control who has access to the lake. If Members do not adhere to this Boat Ramp Access Policy, the number of boat ramps makes it impossible to have Security Personnel at each location at all hours of the day/night to stop unauthorized watercraft from being placed on the lake. Once a boat is launched, it is on our lake for the season except for off-lake Members who use the ramp each time their watercraft is placed in the water.

Keeping unauthorized watercraft off the lake is dependent on members to act responsibly. Member dues support keeping the weeds under control and fish stocked in the lake. Is it fair that those who are delinquent in paying their dues or don't live in the Association are able to gain access to the lake and enjoy everything that the lake has to offer?

If a Member is found to be abusing this policy by allowing others to use their ramp access, they will be subject to sanctions as described in the Boat Ramp Access Agreement signed by the member.

If asked by anyone to borrow your ramp access direct them to contact the Association Office to obtain their own ramp access.
