

HELP NEEDED

Help is needed for Fireworks Display on the evening of July 1 or July 2 in case of rain date.

- 1. Requesting the use of a pontoon boat during the fireworks on evening of Saturday, July 1 or Sunday, July 2 in case of rain date as standby at Bedford East Park to provide emergency transport should an accident occur, and person (s) need to be evacuated from the island to emergency transport at Nottingham Park.
- Requesting assistance on evening of Saturday, July 1 or Sunday, July 2 in case of rain date from up to two members with boats to circle the no entry/fall out zone around the island to ensure boats do not park within the fall out zone.

Lake Columbia Fireworks Display

Saturday, July 1st

or

Sunday July 2^{nd} (rain date)

Bedford East Park users: Friday, June 30 Day before the event – Greg Goings and his crew will arrive at Bedford East Park with fireworks equipment for transport and set up on the island. Actual fireworks are not included in this delivery. Greg will rope off an area at the park with yellow caution tape for his operations and use the pontoon for equipment transport.

Bedford East Park users: Saturday, July 1 or Sunday, July 2 Day of the event – Greg Goings will deliver the fireworks and transport to the island. Set up, wiring and programming will be completed during the day. Members should be advised the island and immediate surrounding area in the lake is off limits and warned to maintain a safe distance from the island during the day.

Nottingham Park users: Saturday, July 1 or Sunday, July 2 early in the morning, the parking spaces at Nottingham Park will be closed off for the Fire Department's boat launch and other vehicles during the event. The Fire Department will store emergency equipment at Nottingham Park and conduct emergency procedures from the park if necessary. Township Fire department will arrive at Nottingham Park prior to the event with a Rescue/First Response Truck and possibly a Fire Truck and boat. The fire department will be present with 6 to 8 members during the event.
